

2019 Redwood Empire Junior Golf Program Information

1. The Redwood Empire Junior Golf (REJG) summer program is open to all K-8 grammar school kids. Beginners through experience golfers are welcome. We ask golfers under the age of 8 to be accompanied by an adult.
2. Our goals are to introduce the game of golf, to teach life skills through the game of golf and to increase local participation in middle school, high school, and local junior golf competition.
3. The junior golf program is now recognized as a Club member benefit by the REG&CC Board of Directors and the new name aligns with the Club branding. In addition, participants and helpers are now protected by the Club's liability insurance.
4. This year's program will be limited to 20 juniors. There will be a two-week 'Priority Registration' window beginning May 1, 2019, for REG&CC member children and grandchildren. Open registration begins May 15, 2019, until the program is full. Follow the instructions at the bottom of this page and refer to the attached forms. The \$50 fee helps cover equipment, supplies, range balls, professional group lessons as well as the year-end awards and pool/pizza party.
5. Roughly half of the golfers will be assigned to Group 1 which is typically the younger and less experienced golfers. The other half will be assigned to Group 2 which is typically the older/more experience golfers. The program coordinators will make initial assessments and assignments of groups before the program begins and we will be in touch.
6. Group 1 will be one-hour sessions from 3 to 4 PM on Wednesdays and Thursdays. Plan to arrive a few minutes early to check in and get setup. This group will focus on basic skills, some professional instruction by Greg and Brian, some fun competitions, and hopefully some time out on course. Parents should make plans to pick up their kids by 4:00 PM to allow the helpers and instructors to focus on the second group sessions.
7. Group 2 will be one-hour sessions from 4 to 5 PM on Wednesdays and Thursdays. Plan to arrive a few minutes early to check in and get setup. This group will focus on basic skills, some professional instruction by Greg and Brian, some fun competitions, and some time out on course. Parents should make plans to pick up their kids by 5:00 PM.
