

Redwood Empire Junior Golf

“Rules and Regulations”

1. Redwood Empire Junior Golf (REJG) Members are allowed to practice and play at Redwood Empire Golf and Country Club on Wednesdays and Thursdays in accordance with the published summer REJG program schedule. REJG members who are also Redwood Empire members may play at any time.
2. An approved roster of REJG golfers will be provided to the Redwood Empire Pro Shop at the start of the program. To be approved the junior golfer must be fully registered and the junior golfer and a parent/guardian must read and sign this “Rules and Regulations” form and return it to the program coordinators.
3. All REJG members must be properly supervised by a registered program helper, parent, or grandparent when using the practice facilities or scheduled on-course competition. Junior golfers are expected to follow the instructions of the helpers and REGCC staff. If they fail to do so they may be removed from the program.
4. No more than 50% of the driving range or practice area will be used by the program.
5. No REJG members or helpers will be allowed on the golf course unless approved by the Head Professional or Assistant Professional. On course play will only be allowed in accordance to the published REJG program schedule or if approved by the Head Professional or Assistant Professional. Play is permitted off the FIRST TEE only, unless approved by the Golf Professional.
6. Dress Code: (See Attached Dress Code)
7. REJG Group 1 golfers should arrive 10 minutes before the 3:00 PM practice time to get set up. Parents should arrange to have the Group 1 golfers picked up by 4:00 PM.
8. REJG Group 2 golfers should arrive 10 minutes before the 4:00 PM start time to get set up. Parents should arrange to have the Group 2 golfers picked up by 5:00 PM.
9. No Loitering: Junior golfers are not allowed to loiter in and around the Pro-Shop or Clubhouse area.
10. Those REJG juniors that do not follow the rules and regulations set forth may be remove from the program and not be permitted to use the facility.
11. Remember, the use of the Redwood Empire Golf and Country Club is a privilege, not a right. Respect the course, staff, and volunteers that make this possible.
